Epistle Reading: St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians 9:2-12

Prokeimenon. Mode 2. Psalm 117.14,18

The Lord is my strength and my song.

Verse: The Lord has chastened me sorely.



Brethren, you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord. This is my defense to those who would examine me. Do we not have the right to our food and drink? Do we not have the right to be accompanied by a wife, as the other apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas? Or is it only Barnabas and I who have no right to refrain from working for a living? Who serves as a soldier at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard without eating any of its fruit? Who tends a flock without

getting some of the milk? Do I say this on human authority? Does not the law say the same? For it is written in the law of Moses, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it is treading out the grain." Is it for oxen that God is concerned? Does he not speak entirely for our sake? It was written for our sake, because the plowman should plow in hope and the thresher thresh in hope of a share in the crop. If we have sown spiritual good among you, is it too much if we reap your material benefits? If others share this rightful claim upon you, do not we still more? Nevertheless, we have not made use of this right, but we endure anything rather than put an obstacle in the way of the gospel of Christ.

Gospel Reading: The Gospel According to Matthew 18:23-35



The Lord said this parable: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants. When he began the reckoning, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents; and as he could not pay, his lord ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made. So the servant fell on his knees, imploring him, 'Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.' And out of pity for him the lord

of that servant released him and forgave him the debt. But that same servant, as he went out, came upon one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and seizing him by the throat he said, 'Pay what you owe.' So his fellow servant fell down and besought him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you.' He refused and went and put him in prison till he should pay the debt. When his fellow servants saw what had taken place, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their lord all that had taken place. Then his lord summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you besought me; and should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' And in anger his lord delivered him to the jailors, till he should pay all his debt. So also my heavenly Father will do to everyone of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart."

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

St. Anna Pray for Us!

Now that a precious Relic of our Matron St. Anna is in the care and stewardship of our community, we can look forward to the countless

blessings that come from this close and physical proximity to her, whom the Church names as our "Most Glorious Ancestor of God."

In September, we will begin Monthly Paraklesis Services to St. Anna (similar to the service chanted to the Most Holy Theotokos in August). These services will take place on the fourth Friday of every month at 7:00 pm. This supplicatory Cannon is chanted in the hope that our St. Anna will hear our prayers and present them upon the Throne of our God, her God and her maternal Grandson, our Lord Jesus Christ.

We have begun to make preparations for a shrine space within our sanctuary, dedicated to the ministry of St. Anna, and a space to appropriately display her holy Relic for veneration. There will be several opportunities for us, the faithful of St. Anna's parish, to participate in the purchase of the elements that are necessary to produce such an environment. That said, please look upon the following needs of our parish and help us in the creation of our shrine. For your prayerful consideration...

Altar Table Materials:	\$600.00
Reliquary	\$2,600.00
2 Altar Candlesticks (Includes wax-less candles):	\$1,100.00
Altar Oil Lamp:	\$950.00
Large Icon of the Dormition of St. Anna with Frame (similar to our St. Anna icon in the narthex):	\$1,500.00
Small Icon of the Conception of the Theotokos with Frame:	\$1,000.00
Small Icon of the Nativity of the Theotokos with Frame (will be finished in time for the Feast on December 9, 2018):	\$1,000.00

These sacred objects, though a permanent investment in the liturgical life of our church, are all items that will move with us to a permanent location. That is, when St. Anna produces such a location for us!
