Epistle Reading: St. Paul's First Letter to the Galatians 2:16-20

Prokeimenon. Mode 4 Psalm 103

O Lord, save Your people, and bless Your inheritance

Verse: To You, O Lord, I cry; O my God



Brethren, you know that a man is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ, and not by works of the law, because by works of the law shall no one be justified. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we ourselves were found to be sinners, is Christ then an agent of sin? Certainly not! But if I build up again those things which I tore down, then I prove myself a transgressor. For I through the law died to the law, that I might live to God. I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

For whoever is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of man also be ashamed, when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels." And he said to them, "Truly, I say to you, there are

some standing here who will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God come with power."

New Way to Pay Your Stewardship and Other Church Donations:

The Parish Council is excited to announce that stewardship and other donations to St. Anna Greek Orthodox Church can now be quickly and easily made via text message using GIVE+ Text, a text donation platform offered through Vanco, our online donation partner.

To make your first donation to St. Anna Greek Orthodox Church

via text message, follow these four simple steps:

1. Send a text message to 844-936-2414 (St. Anna's dedicated Give+ Text number), stating the amount you would like to donate followed by the account code in the body of the text, using the following format: \$xx 0x. The available account codes are as follows:

03-Building Fund

04-Miscellaneous giving

05-Candles-Pangari

06-Candles-Vigil

2. You will receive a return text message containing a link for you to complete your donation.

3. Click on the link in the return text to enter your name, address and credit card information and register yourself as a Give+ Text user.

4. You will receive another text message confirming your donation.

Future text donations are even easier! All you have to do is text the amount you want to donate followed by the applicable account code (\$xx 0x) to 844-936-2414 (St. Anna's dedicated Give+ Text number). The credit card entered at the time of your initial registration will be charged your donation amount, and you will receive a confirming text message.

Parish Council Meeting: The next Parish Council meeting will be held, tomorrow, Monday, September 21, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Fr. Anthony is beginning discussions with ministry leaders to get classes, Bible Studies and Virtual Fellowship Times up as soon as possible. We will continue to explore all possible avenues to keep us connected as a family of faith.

Reservations for Sunday Liturgy Commencing October 4, 2020:

In order to maintain social distancing, attendance at Sunday Liturgy is currently limited to 80 people. Commencing **Sunday, October 4, 2020**, advanced reservations will be required to attend. You will need to reserve a spot for anyone in your household who plans to attend services each Sunday. Reservations can be made online at bookwhen.com/stanna.

Reservations will open 7-days in advance of each service. For example, if you wish to attend the service on Sunday, October 4, 2020, reservations will open on Sunday September 27, 2020; if you wish to attend the service on Sunday, October 11, 2020, reservations will open on Sunday, October 4, 2020; etc.

If all available spots have been filled on any given Sunday, you may be placed on our wait list. If someone cancels their reservation, you will receive an email alerting you that a spot has opened up, and asking you to reserve your desired number of seats. If you are unable to secure a space for liturgy on any given Sunday, please join us via our live stream and try again the following week.

Every other week, we will have in-person Sunday School. On those Sundays, the families of our Sunday School students and teachers will have first priority for attendance, on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you are not a Sunday School family, or teacher and we run out of space for that week, you may receive a call or email asking you to participate via live stream that Sunday. On Sundays where no in-person Sunday School is scheduled, reservations will be first-come first-serve for all.

We regret having to limit attendance at church, but it is necessary due to the effects of this international pandemic. It is our fervent prayer that we will be able to eliminate these restrictions and welcome all parishioners back for live worship very soon.

MAKING YOUR RESERVATION TO ATTEND LITURGY

Follow the steps below to reserve your spot online, using your desktop or using your mobile device:

- Select the specific service you wish to attend
- Scroll to the bottom right and click “Select”
- Choose the number of people planning to attend
- Click “View Selections”
- Confirm your desired number of seats and click “Book Now”
- Enter your email address and click “Continue”
- Insert the name of **each** person planning to attend service
- If this is a booking on a Sunday where we are offering in-person Sunday School, you will be asked to identify whether you are a Sunday School family by clicking yes or no. If this is a booking for a Sunday where in-person Sunday School is not being offered, this field will not appear in the booking form
- Click “Continue”
- Check your email for a confirmation
